Public Hearing for the Following Ordinances

Ordinance 2014-06 "AN ORDINANCE TO DEVELOP A JOINTLY OWNED AND OPERATED INDUSTRIAL/BUSINESS PARK (PROJECT STAR) IN CONJUNCTION WITH PICKENS COUNTY, SUCH INDUSTRIAL/ BUSINESS PARK TO BE GEOGRAPHICALLY LOCATED IN OCONEE COUNTY AND ESTABLISHED PURSUANT TO SOUTH CAROLINA CODE OF LAWS OF 1976 §4-1-170, ET SEQUITUR, AS AMENDED; TO PROVIDE FOR A WRITTEN AGREEMENT WITH PICKENS COUNTY PROVIDING FOR THE EXPENSES OF THE PARK, THE PERCENTAGE OF REVENUE APPLICATION, AND THE DISTRIBUTION OF FEES IN LIEU OF AD VALOREM TAXES TO THE COUNTIES AND RELEVANT TAXING ENTITIES; TO PROVIDE THAT JOB TAX CREDITS ALLOWED BY LAW BE PROVIDED FOR BUSINESSES LOCATING IN SAID PARK; TO PERMIT A USER FEE IN LIEU OF AD VALOREM TAXATION WITHIN SAID PARK; AND TO AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTION AND DELIVERY OF AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF SENECA RELATED TO THE CREATION OF THE PARK WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF SENECA AND THE DISTRIBUTION OF CERTAIN FEES IN LIEU OF AD VALOREM TAXES DUE TO OCONEE COUNTY FROM THE PARK, AND THE PAYMENT BY OCONEE COUNTY TO THE CITY OF SENECA OF AN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT GRANT, SOLELY FOR THE USE OF THE CITY OF THE SENECA FOR SERENE HOSPITALITY, LLC; AND TO AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTION AND DELIVERY OF AN INFRASTRUCTURE TAX CREDIT AGREEMENT BETWEEN OCONEE COUNTY AND SERENE HOSPITALITY, LLC; AND OTHER MATTERS RELATED THERETO, INCLUDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, THE AUTHORIZATION OF AN INFRASTRUCTURE TAX CREDIT IN FAVOR OF SERENE HOSPITALITY, LLC"

Ordinance 2014-08 "AN ORDINANCE CALLING FOR A REFERENDUM TO AUTHORIZE THE SOUTH CAROLINA DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE TO ISSUE TEMPORARY PERMITS TO ALLOW FOR THE POSSESSION, SALE, AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUORS BY THE DRINK TO BONA FIDE NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS AND BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS AUTHORIZED TO BE LICENSED FOR CONSUMPTION-ON-PREMISES SALES AND TO ALLOW THE SALE OF BEER AND WINE AT PERMITTED OFF-PREMISES LOCATIONS WITHOUT REGARD TO THE DAYS OR HOURS OF SALE; AND OTHER MATTERS RELATED THERETO"

Resolution R2014-09 "A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION AND DELIVERY OF AN INDUCEMENT AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN OCONEE COUNTY, SOUTH CAROLINA AND PROJECT TAU, WHEREBY, UNDER CERTAIN CONDITIONS, OCONEE COUNTY WILL EXECUTE A FEE IN LIEU OF TAX AGREEMENT FOR A PROJECT INVOLVING NOT LESS THAN TWO MILLION FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$2,500,000) INVESTMENT"

Mr. Dexter made a motion, seconded by Mr. Corbeil, approved 4 - 0 to approve **Resolution R2014-09** on first and final reading.

Resolution R2014-10 "A RESOLUTION ACKNOWLEDGING AND CONSENTING TO THE ACQUISITION OF AND NAME CHANGE OF AID COMPANY LLC TO RBC AEROSTRUCTURES LLC IN CONNECTION WITH A FEE IN LIEU OF TAX AGREEMENT WITH OCONEE COUNTY"

Mr. Corbeil made a motion, seconded by Mr. Dexter, approved 4-0 to approve **Resolution R2014-10** on first and final reading.

Detention Center / Guaranteed Maximum Price & Project Budget Approval

Mr. McCall made a motion, seconded by Mr. Corbeil, approved 4-0 to approve the Detention Center Project budget and CMaR Guaranteed Maximum Price of 16,253,068 to begin Construction on April 2, 2014. (see April 15, 2014, regular minutes for additional authorization)

ITB 13-09 Wastewater System Improvements to Serve the Golden Corner Commerce Park / New 1,800 GPM Pump Station / \$2,304,500.00

Mr. Dexter made a motion, seconded by Mr. Corbeil, approved 4-0 to (1) approve the award of ITB 13-09 to The Harper Corporation of Greenville, SC, for the Wastewater System Improvements to Serve the Golden Corner Commerce Park -1,800 GPM Pump Station, in the amount of \$2,095,000.00, and a contingency amount of 10% for any change orders that may arise, for a total award amount of \$2,304,500.00, and (2) authorize the County Administrator to approve any change orders that are within the contingency amount.

Local ATAX Requests / Up to \$12,500

- Marketing Banners / Up to \$2,500
- Host Road Titans 300 Cycling Challenge / \$10,000

Mr. Corbeil made a motion, seconded by Mr. McCall, approved 4-0 to [1] approve up to \$2,500 from Local ATAX fund for marketing banners and additions to the logo tent & [2] approve \$10,000 from local ATAX to host the Road Titans 300 cycling challenge in November 2014.

Old Business:

Holder's Landing / Corp of Engineers

Mr. McCall made a motion, seconded by Mr. Corbeil, approved 4-0 to approve adding Holders Landing to the Corps of Engineers lease list with the proviso [1] the citizen group continue to maintain the site as agreed upon, and [2] the County will continue to lease this site until such time as capital upgrades are required by the Corps.

New Business:

State Park Mulch Donation

Mr. McCall made a motion, seconded by Mr. Corbeil, approved 4-0 to approve sustaining the level of mulch provided to SC PRT for Devils Fork State Park and Oconee State Park in an amount not to exceed \$2,500 with the proviso that SC PRT continue to provide their hauling at their expense.

Mr. McCall made a motion, seconded by Mr. Dexter, approved 4-0 to approve splitting Public Comment for Agenda and Non-Agenda Items; moving non-agenda public comment to the end of meeting prior to adjournment.
