

# MINUTES OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING Regular Meeting August 19, 2014

# Second Reading of the Following Ordinances

Ordinance 2014-11 "AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 38 "ZONING" OF THE OCONEE COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES, INCLUDING ALL ZONING MAPS INCORPORATED THEREIN AND THEREBY, IN CERTAIN LIMITED REGARDS AND PARTICULARS, ONLY; AND OTHER MATTERS RELATED THERETO" [2014 SUB01]

Mr. McCall made a motion, seconded by Mr. Cain, to approve **Ordinances 2014-11** on second reading. Discussion followed.

Mr. Cain made a motion, seconded by Mr. McCall, approved 4 - 0 to amend **Ordinance 2014-11** to include parcel 099-00-01-002 as recommended by the Planning Commission.

Lengthy discussion followed regarding the applicants purpose for the rezoning request and the recent action by the Planning Commission to recommend to Council to amend the requirements for rezoning applications to include the reason for the request/intended purpose.

Mr. Thrift called for the vote. The motion passed 3 - 1 [Mr. Corbeil opposed] to approve **Ordinance 2014-11** on second reading as amended.

# **First Reading of the Following Ordinances**

**Ordinance 2014-16** *[in title only]* "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE OCONEE COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES, **ARTS AND HISTORICAL COMMISSION;** REVISING CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE IV, DIVISION 4, SECTIONS 321-326; AND OTHER MATTERS RELATED THERETO"

Mr. McCall made a motion, seconded by Mr. Cain, approved 4 - 0, to approve **Ordinances 2014-16** on first reading in title only.

# **Ordinance 2014-19** *[in title only]* "AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CONVEYANCE OF CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY BY AND FROM OCONEE COUNTY, SOUTH CAROLINA; AND OTHER MATTERS RELATING THERETO"

Mr. Cain made a motion, seconded by Mr. McCall, approved 4 - 0, to approve **Ordinances 2014-19** on first reading in title only.

**Ordinance 2014-21** *[in title only]* "AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CONVEYANCE OF CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY BY AND FROM OCONEE COUNTY, SOUTH CAROLINA; AND OTHER MATTERS RELATING THERETO"

Mr. Cain made a motion, seconded by Mr. Corbeil, approved 4 - 0, to approve **Ordinances 2014-21** on first reading in title only.

## **Discussion Regarding Action Items:**

Mr. Moulder addressed Council regarding all Action Items listed below.

#### Purchase of 4 parcels / Airport Safety Issue / Not to exceed \$5,950

Mr. Corbeil made a motion, seconded by Mr. McCall, approved 4 - 0 to [1] approve the fee simple purchase of the four parcels of real property for a total cost of \$81,500 (\$72,000 for land and \$9,500 for legal and closing costs), with a total cost to the County of \$5,950, some or all of which may be paid by grant (see notes below), and [2] authorize the County Administrator to execute any sales agreement with land owner (Haiyan Lin) on behalf of Oconee County.

#### RFP 12-15 / Continuation of Construction Projects / Project FOCUS / \$200,000

Mr. Cain made a motion, seconded by Mr. Corbeil, to award this bid. Lengthy discussion followed. Mr. McCall voiced concerns regarding the length of time this project is taking and the expansion of the project.

Mr. Moulder outlined the initial scope of the project and the issues related with the ISP's unwillingness to fund the final miles of the project. He stated that a one price fits all scenario won't work due to the variables with each expansion to include topography, length from middle mile, density of end users, rock, etc. Mr. Moulder stated that our pricing is less than that being charged by the big companies citizens are familiar with advertising on TV. Lastly, he stated that he is working one on one with each provider to develop pricing to build in recouping the county's cost for construction over a reasonable time period without creating a pricing structure that is cost prohibitive for the citizens.

Mr. Thrift called for the vote. The motion passed 4 - 0 to award for construction work relating to Broadband projects to GeoVision of Sylva, NC for a not-to-exceed amount of \$200,000 for FY 2014-2015.

#### ITB 14-01 / Road Paving 2014-2015 / \$579,581.70

Mr. McCall made a motion, seconded by Mr. Corbeil, approved 4 - 0 to (1) approve the Award of ITB 14-01, Road Paving 2014-2015 to Hubbard Paving & Grading, Inc., of Walhalla, SC, in the amount of \$526,892.45 plus contingency in the amount of \$52,689.25 for a total award of \$579,581.70. Staff also recommends Council (2) authorize the County Administrator to approve any change orders within the contingency amount.

#### Mauldin Mill Road Bridge / Roads & Bridges / \$55,375

Mr. McCall made a motion, seconded by Mr. Corbeil, approved 4 - 0 to approve the award of \$55,375.00 to Davis & Floyd, Inc., of Greenwood, SC for engineering services for the road and bridge design of Mauldin Mill Road over Richland Creek.

#### Goodyear Tires / State Contract / Vehicle Maintenance & Quarry / \$90,000 (Estimated)

Mr. Corbeil made a motion, seconded by Mr. McCall, approved 4 - 0 to (1) approve the purchase of Goodyear tires as needed from Super Service Tire & Alignment of Walhalla, SC for an estimated amount of \$90,000 for fiscal year 2014-15; and (2) allow the County Administrator to approve future purchases from state contract for the next five year period or through FY 2018-2019, as long as all purchases for Goodyear tires are in accordance with the State Contract award and amounts do not exceed amounts budgeted for tire purchases.

# **Council Committee Reports**

#### Real Estate, Facilities & Land Management Committee / Mr. Cain

Mr. Cain read from a prepared statement [copy filed with these minutes] outlining the activities of the Committee at their August 12, 2014 meeting.

Mr. Cain made a motion, seconded by Mr. McCall, approved 4 - 0 to [1] direct the administrator to work out detail for the donation of the Coroner's Building on Short Street, Walhalla potentially to the Museum of the Cherokee and/or Patriots Hall, and [2] direct the Administrator to develop a draft policy regarding disposition of county owned buildings that are deemed of no use to the county.

Mr. Cain noted that a representative of the Oconee Courthouse Ventures, LLC. had contacted him via email after the committee meeting requesting a 4-6 month extension on the lease in order to get their funding in order.

Mr. Cain made a motion to extend Oconee Courthouse Ventures, LLC. lease agreement for 4-6 month to allow them to get their funding in order.

Mr. Corbeil made a motion to require from Oconee Courthouse Ventures, LLC a written financial plan document outlining specific funding commitments for the project for Council's consideration and possible action at the September 16, 2014 Council meeting.

Lengthy discussion followed prior to a second.

Mr. Cain withdrew his motion.

Mr. Thrift requested action regarding the open motion on the table. Mr. McCall seconded Mr. Corbeil's motion to require from Oconee Courthouse Ventures, LLC a written financial plan document outlining specific funding commitments for the project for Council's consideration and possible action at the September 16, 2014 Council meeting. Mr. Thrift called for the vote; the motion passed 4 - 0.

Mr. Cain noted that he had spoken with the current representative who has agreed to serve out his term through December 2014; therefore, this matter is deferred to first quarter 2015 for appointment.
