Fiscal Year 2016-2017 Tri-County Technical College [TCTC] Budget Presentation:

Dr. Ronnie Booth gave a presentation utilizing a PowerPoint presentation [copy filed with these minutes] outlining their FY 2016-2017 budget request. Dr. Booth noted that funding for the Student Success Center listed in the request is not needed during this funding cycle as the project is behind schedule. Additionally, he acknowledged that Council had in previous meetings noted that funding would not be provided until FY 2017-2018 at the earliest and that ongoing work related to the Oconee County campus was a part of the approval process also.

Discussion followed regarding various aspects of their budget to include but not limited to: TCTC's commitment to key curriculum at the Oconee County campus; TCTC partnership with the School District of Oconee [SDOC] and Adult Education; retraining of laid off county residents, etc.
