Oconee County Council met at 6:00 PM in Council Chambers, 415 South Pine Street, Walhalla, SC with all Council Members, County Administrator Amanda F. Brock, County Attorney David Root, & Jennifer C. Adams, Clerk to Council present.

Call to Order

Mr. Elliott called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Mr. Elliott opened the meeting reminding the public they have two opportunities to speak during Council meetings, which is during the public comment session and also during the public hearing session, if scheduled. Other than those two instances, the public should remain silent during the Council meeting. Anyone making a disturbance during the meeting will be asked to leave Council Chambers for the remainder of the meeting.

Moment of Silence

Mr. Root asked for a moment of silence prior to the Invocation by County Council Chaplain.

Invocation by County Council Chaplain

Mr. Root, County Council Chaplain, gave the invocation.

Attorney's Comments

Mr. Root addressed Council with a request to amend the agenda to remove Board and Commission Appointments and Executive Session items number four and six.

Mr. Davis made a motion, seconded by Mr. Hart, approved 4 - 0, to amend the agenda to remove Board and Commission Appointments and Executive Session items number four and six.

Administrator's Comments

Ms. Brock offered a reminder of the Budget Workshop, scheduled for this Friday, March 24, 2023 at 9 a.m. in Council Chambers.

Presentation to Council

Ms. Brock introduced Ms. Lisa Jones, providing details on her experience in agricultural preservation, noting Ms. Jones was hired as a consultant for the Oconee County Taskforce on Agriculture.

Ms. Jones presented the "Oconee County Taskforce on Agriculture Final Report" [copy filed in backup] to Council and gave a brief overview of the taskforce's findings and recommendations.

- 3. Ms. Candy Bianco addressed Council asking for more transparency on Sewer South, Resolutions 2023-05 and 2023-06, and the topic of additional student housing.

Council Members Comments

Mr. Elliott addressed Mr. Lutz's concern and made a motion to direct County Administrator and Council Clerk to draft a letter from County Council to County Delegation, with a copy to Governor McMaster, opposing the Compassionate Care Act.

Mr. Davis noted that he would need more information before supporting this motion.

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Mr. Elliott requested this topic to be included on the next meeting agenda to allow time for Mr. Davis to review more information.

Mr. Davis addressed Ms. Michelle Balon's concerns related to litter within the County and Ms. Candy Bianco's request concerning transparency.

Ms. Brock offered information in regard to Ms. Bianco's request for transparency related to Resolution's 2023-05 and 2023-06, clarifying that Economic Development matters are typically held exempt from the Freedom of Information Act until certain announcements from the company are released.

Mr. Root added that the resolutions on the agenda for tonight are Inducement Resolutions and are not final, just preliminary for the companies to move forward, noting that ordinances would follow these preliminary resolutions with three readings.

Mr. Elliott offered comments related to the litter problem in Oconee County.

Ms. Balon was invited back to the podium by Mr. Elliott where she urged Council to consider an advisory committee to address litter issues within the County.

Mr. Davis made a motion, seconded by Mr. Hart, to approve **Resolution 2023-05** on first and final reading.

RESOLUTION 2023-06 PROVIDING PRELIMINARY APPROVAL PURSUANT TO TITLE 12, CHAPTER 44 OF THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA 1976, AS AMENDED, FOR THE EXECUTION AND DELIVERY OF A FEE-IN-LIEU OF AD VALOREM TAXES AND SPECIAL SOURCE REVENUE CREDIT AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN OCONEE COUNTY, SOUTH CAROLINA, AND A COMPANY IDENTIFIED FOR THE TIME BEING AS PROJECT MADE, ACTING FOR ITSELF, ONE OR MORE CURRENT OR FUTURE AFFILIATES, AND OTHER PROJECT COMPANIES (COLLECTIVELY, "COMPANY"); PROVIDING FOR A FEE-IN-LIEU OF AD VALOREM TAXES INCENTIVE; PROVIDING FOR A SPECIAL SOURCE REVENUE CREDIT; CREATING A JOINT COUNTY INDUSTRIAL AND BUSINESS PARK BETWEEN OCONEE COUNTY AND PICKENS COUNTY SO AS TO INLCUDE PROJECT PROPERTY IN THE PARK; AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION AND DELIVERY OF ONE MORE GRANT AGREEMENTS; AND OTHER RELATED MATTERS.

Mr. Davis made a motion, seconded by Mr. Hart, approved 4 - 0, to approve **Resolution 2023-06** in first and final reading.

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Discussion Regarding Action Items

PRT Commission Local ATAX Recommendations Spring 2023 Cycle / \$85,326

A portion of Local ATAX revenues received by Oconee County are made available for ATAX grants through Ordinance 2011-12. ATAX grants are to be tourism related grants that meet the ATAX guidelines specified by local and State mandates. Grants are recommended by the PRT Commission based on tourism impact of the project and approved by County Council. All external ATAX grant recipients are required to turn in intermediate reports every 60 days to the progress of the grant and a final report upon completion of the grant.

These reports are placed in the grant folder, which is kept active by the PRT staff until the grant is considered complete. Internal projects through Oconee PRT are also funneled through local ATAX for eligible projects.

Beginning Local ATAX balance: \$555,687

If all grants/projects approved/new balance will be: \$470,361

Are Matching Funds Available: Yes

If yes, who is matching and how much: Varies by grant

It is the staff's recommendation that Council approve the local ATAX recommendations per the attached spreadsheet.
