1. Mr. Tony Adams addressed Council with his opinions related to the FY2023-2024 Budget, the proposed salary step and scale, and the School District of Oconee County.

## **Council Member Comments**

Mr. Hart inquired about debris buildup at Solid Waste due to the tub grinder being down, noting he would like to see if this equipment could be repaired quickly.

Mr. Hart added comments related to contracted labor at the Solid Waste Department.

Mr. Davis responded to Mr. Adams comments related to the School District of Oconee County.

Mr. Mize stated, "I would like to go on record, public record, saying that this Council is all for the employees of Oconee County".

Mr. Mize continued with comments related to the wage and labor study and employee salaries, asking that all employees be patient with Council as they work through this process.

Mr. Durham inquired as to why dump trucks are having to back into the landfill to dump their loads.

Ms. Brock provided the reason as to why dump trucks and dump trailers are being required to back into the landfill, noting this process has been in place for a while and that the previous dump site can no longer hold the weight of these trucks and trailers.

Short discussion between Council and Ms. Brock followed related to dumping at the landfill and equipment repair at the Solid Waste Department.
