

**Oconee County Airport  
Director's Report**

**January 14**

**Airfield** - All Pavement maintenance work is complete. All Airfield Lighting/sign systems are operating normally. During calendar year 2013 the airport has received 81.02 inches of rain....(unofficially). This is twice the normal annual rainfall for this area.

**Safety /Security Issues** – Rwy 7 Approach Safety - FAA Terminal Enroute Procedures Planner Jon Walker has advised us two of our GPS approaches have been NOTAMed “Not Authorized” due to penetrations of the Glideslope Qualification Surface. There are two remaining instrument approach procedures for Rwy 7: a Localizer Navigation (LNAV) approach with a higher Minimum Descent Altitude (MDA) and a circling approach with higher minimums. This action by FAA warrants us to take those necessary steps to remove or relocate all approach surface obstructions. Doing so will ensure the Rwy 7 approach is usable at night and in all weather conditions.

**Airport Legal Issues** - None to report at this time.

**Capital Projects** - The restroom upgrade to Hangar E is complete and the work has been inspected by County building dept personnel. Hangar rents are now \$250 per month WK Dickson has compiled and Mr. Moulder has signed the annual update to our 5 yr AIP airport project list. The update includes an AIP grant request for \$260,000 in the current FY and \$1.82 million in FY 2015. The highest priority project is obstruction clearing for the Runway 7 approach.

**Terminal / Facilities Issues-** The SC Div of Aeronautics has assisted us in purchasing 5 new LED security lights for the T-hangar buildings. Because this involves airport maintenance, the SCDOA agreed to purchase the lights with the stipulation that the county install them at our expense. We hope to do more light replacement with this arrangement in the future and standardize all hangar exterior lighting.

**Operations** - Cold weather is upon us and there have been a few cold temperature related equipment issues to resolve. No unresolvable issues have come up.

**Personnel Issues** – Mr. Steve Robbins has been on-staff now for over 2 months and is a welcome addition. He has very good computer skills and is a quick study. The new time clock system is now on-line and staff has adjusted quickly to the new procedures.
