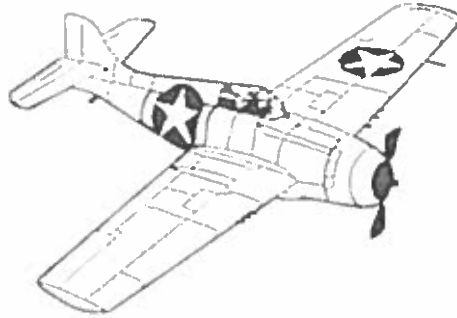


# Oconee County Regional Airport
