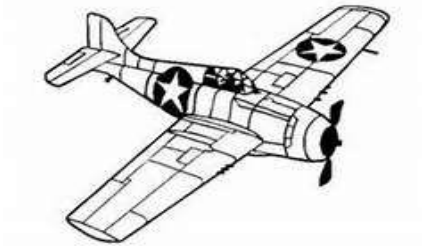


Oconee County Regional Airport Directors Report: MAY 7, 2019
