LIMITED IN-PERSON ATTENDANCE PERMITTED

Due to the Novel Coronavirus pandemic and the ongoing state of emergency, in-person attendance at this Commission meeting by members of the general public will be limited. Attendance will be limited to twenty percent of the stated maximum occupancy, which equates to thirty-four (34) persons (including Council members, other elected officials, and staff). Attendees will be required to sit in designated seats, appropriately spaced. In-person attendance will be allowed on a "first-come" basis. - 5. Right-to-Farm Act proclamation Ms. Gray made a motion to accept the Right-to-Farm Act with edits and amendments as discussed, seconded by Mr. Hollifield, and approved 6/0. In Paragraph 5, "and it is the farmer who must comply, even when" was removed and replaced by "if they are not abiding by all laws and regulations;". Paragraph 7 will close at the word "therein." and all verbiage after was deleted.
- Farmer's resource guide Ms. Gray will email Mr. Chapman the most current draft of the resource guide so Mr. Chapman can email to all board members. Members should review and send proposed edits to Ms. Gray. Ms. Gray to send final draft to Mr. Chapman to convert to appropriate format for Oconee County website.
- Adjourn Mr. Blanton thanked Ed Land, who recently resigned from Board, for his service to the Board and Oconee County. Ms. Alexander made a motion to adjourn meeting, seconded by Mr. Hollifield, and approved unanimously at 7:10 PM.
