- I. Call to Order: meeting called to order at 5:30 PM
- II. Approval of minutes: September 24, 2024 regular meeting. Motion to approve Miranda;, second Henderson. Approved unanimously.

B. Discuss progress on ADA ramp in Seneca: county has received a preliminary bid from Satchel Construction in Greenville, SC, for \$132,885. County Council will need to pass an ordinance to supplement the original amount passed by them earlier in the year of \$57,000. Three readings of the ordinance and a public hearing would be required.
