The Oconee County Rescue Squad Advisory Commission met at 6:00 PM in the conference room, 415 South Pine Street, Walhalla. Kelly McCormick, Tammy Wilbanks, Brady Land, Steven Zahn, Eric Sprogis, Director Scott Krein and Mike Carroll were present.

- 1. Call to order Commissioner McCormick called the meeting to order at 1800 hours.
- **2. Approval of Minutes -** Commissioner Land made a motion to approve the minutes from February 23, 2023, seconded by Commissioner Zahn and approved 5-0.

- 5. Commissioner McCormick's Report -none

6. Commissioner Steven Zahn's Report

- a) Helicopter Insurance Question about whether amount for insurance would be placed in the upcoming county budget would have to go out for bids and at this point, would not be in the budget; Would squads/departments that had already purchased this be reimbursed? Not going to be reimbursed.
- EMS radio dispatches Concern about Prisma dispatch's new radio system and county dispatch and responders not being able to hear what is being given to medics
- c) Priority One calls More often than not, there is a reason responders aren't being sent; they try to follow the list of ten calls of priority one calls that was made and through EMD process
- d) New Medical Director wants properly trained personnel responding to scenes, looking at proper medications for EMRs to use, Clinical Operating Guideline review

 - a) Tower at Newry is progressing
 - b) Agreement with county and Duke Energy is almost done for the tower at Bad Creek; Still working on Salem tower: Cleveland tower still on hold

- Training Committee Report
 - a) Still waiting on confirmation about whether EVRA is still available. Commissioner Wilbanks requested to table this vote again until next meeting. Commissioner Zahn stated the course was on the Blackboard for the SC Fire Academy. All other commissioners agreed. VFIS class coming for personnel who only will be driving rescue vehicles.

- Skills Verification forms Being used to record training in order to receive recertication (EMT specific); looking at doing the same for EMR
- Rescue Squad Response Report went over calls/responses per squad (handout)
- Criteria for active member/active squad What is an active member?

9. Director Scott Krein's Report

- Active911 Canceled calls Dispatch cannot send a cancel call message without the call being completely over; Commissioner Land offered a possible solution that Director Krein said he would look into
- Opioid program money to come in for program; there will be a program coordinator to assist with process and training so that we can continue to deliver Narcan; reminder that if Narcan is used, a report must be done immediately
- Budget Hopeful to have budget numbers at next meeting
