# Rudimentary Road Program/Snow Creek Forest Roads

Direction given at October 11, 2016

- The Transportation Committee directed staff to move forward in obtaining all necessary right-of-way to improve Snow Creek Forest Rd per the rudimentary road program ordinance.

# Road Department Operation

- 38 Employees at full staff
- 7 Crews with a staff in the office
  - Asphalt Crew, Pipe Crew, Gravel Maintenance Crew, Construction Crew, Mowing Crew, Arbor Crew, Sign Crew
- 660 miles of county maintained roads (500 miles paved and 160 miles gravel)

# Roads and Bridges Department Budget

- Funds are allotted through the General Fund, Road Maintenance Millage, and Bridge and Culverts Fund.
- Gravel Use, Operational, and Road Paving come from the Road Maintenance Millage.
- Additional funding for Road Paving comes from National Forest Service Funds and C-Funding

# Road Maintenance Millage

- Funding Breakdown:
  - Gravel Use - \$200,000
  - Operational - \$210,000
  - Road Paving -\$631,500
    - Additional Funding from National Forest and C-Funds
- Gravel Use is for maintenance of gravel roads and rock used for other general maintenance
- Operational is used to pay for asphalt for patching roads, sign materials, and various other materials for maintenance needs



# Road Paving Breakdown

- Roads are selected for improvement using PCI (Pavement Condition Index) scores. Road right-of-way is reviewed and required for roads to stay on the list. Utility conflicts are identified. Estimates are created to utilize available funding. Culvert pipes are upgraded on the roads to be paved. Paving Contract is bid out and executed using unit pricing to pay for actual quantities used.
- Additional uses for Road Paving funds:
  - Road Construction (gravel to paved)
  - Striping
  - Crack fill and seal treatments


