_____ Deed to Right-of-Way for entire length of road, (Including cul-de-sac, if applicable.) (Reference: 26.6.3)

_____ Certification from SC Registered Professional Engineer that road meets minimum construction standards
specified in Ordinance 2008-19 Article 6 (must connect to one Federal, State, County or Municipal
roadway). (Reference: 26.6.4 and 8).

Please Note:

It is the applicant's responsibility to supply supporting documentation for the road and not Oconee County's responsibility to research documents, survey or perform other activities to determine the type of roadway. This application must be complete in order to be considered for county maintenance. It is the Transportation Committee's decision whether or not to accept a road after all information is submitted.
