

September 4, 1975

The Oconee County Council meeting was opened by Chairman Bailes with the prayer by Mr. Herring.

Robert Ramey moved to accept the minutes of the August 21st meeting as printed. Mr. Herring seconded and they were approved.

Mrs. Mary Johnson requested permission of Council for a license for Palm Reading in Oconee County. Due to conflict of interest, (the Johnson's were planning to rent a building from a relative of Mr. Bailes.) the Chairman asked Vice Chairman Thomas to preside over this request. Mr. Thomas asked for discussion and after this it was moved by Mr. Ramey to grant the license. Mr. Moore seconded and it passed unanimously.

Reid Garrison spoke to Council of his desire to renew his lease at the Oconee Airport and his desire to do this without the aid of an attorney. Mike Adams and Gene Rochester both of Seneca spoke to Council in Mr. Garrison's behalf. Council assured the interested parties they were sure the Aeronautics Commission would handle the negotiation of the new lease in good faith and fairly.

Councilman Thomas moved the approval of Ordinance 75-11 for 3rd reading with a few minor changes as follows:

It was then moved by Mr. Thomas seconded by Mr. Herring to change the Contingency (670000) fund to \$100,000.00 and establish an account #750000 of \$248,794.71 as an uncollected taxes account. All voted in favor. Mr. Thomas moved then to make correction in account #590000 as state funds were omitted in addition. Mr. Ramey seconded this change and all were in favor. A change to account #620000 to correct error in addition was made by Mr. THOMAS and seconded by Mr. Ramey.
