MINUTES, OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING

The regular meeting of the Oconee County Council was held Tuesday, May 19, 1998 at 3:00 pm in Council Chambers with all Council Members and the County Attorney present.

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor -Chairman Orr who welcomed the guests and media.

Call to Order

The invocation was given by Mr. Thomas.

Invocation

Mr. Hamilton made a motion, seconded by Mrs. Hughes, approved 4 - 0 that the minutes of the May 5, 1998 meeting be adopted as printed.

Minutes

The first item on the agenda was a public hearing to receive written and/or oral comments regarding Ordinance 98-2, "OCONEE COUNTY NOISE CONTROL ORDINANCE".

Public Hearing

Mr. Hansel Eller spoke in favor of a noise ordinance stating he and his family had suffered physically due to loud music being played very late at night and disturbing their rest.

Mr. Carroll Gambrell spoke in favor of a noise control ordinance stating the domestic tranquility of the neighborhood adjoining the gun club had been disturbed.

Mr. Mike Lusk spoke in favor of the noise ordinance stating he was in the process of building a wall to protect his family against stray bullets from the gun club.

Mr. David McMahan spoke in favor of the ordinance, however, he did feel Council needed to reword certain portions of the ordinance taking into consideration the fact that certain construction work is done early in the morning and county residents shoot firecrackers on holidays.

Mr. John Droste asked for a decibel level to be included in the ordinance.

Mr. Peter Droste addressed Council stating that he was being asked to close a business that is his livelihood and he had put his heart and soul into.

Mr. Stu Wright stated he was against any ordinance that targeted a particular business, he further stated that the noise ordinance needed to have a level of sound included in it.

Mr. Frank Galloway stated the gun club was noisy and endangering the lives of surrounding property owners.

Mr. Ron Kopczyk stated he was concerned about certain terminology in the ordinance and stated he felt a person should put their complaint in writing.

Mr. Terry Harper spoke in favor of the ordinance, however, he felt a decibel level should be included in the ordinance.

Mr. Bob Lipscomb stated the peace and tranquility of the Flat Shoals Community had been destroyed.

Mr. Steve Pietrowicz asked that the ordinance be an objective one.

Mr. Joe Nichols stated he had been shot on two occasions and his wife and children had also been hit and that his boys were afraid to play in the woods adjoining his house.

Mr. Tom Droste stated the gun club was started as a sport, for people to have something to do.

Mr. Frank Miller stated the ordinance was too broad, that it needed to have decibel levels.

Mr. Ed Leap felt the ordinance needed to be rewritten.

The last gentleman who spoke felt Council needed to look at the wording of the ordinance, but also that common sense needed to be used by everyone involved.

After the last speaker, Mr. Orr informed those present that the noise ordinance was started some five years ago and was not pointed at the gun club, he further informed those present that the vote on the ordinance would be in two weeks.

Mr. Jay Talbert of Talbert & Bright, Inc., the consulting firm for the airport, gave Council a brief overview of the airport projects. Mr. Talbert informed Council the parallel taxiway and new terminal building is currently in progress. Mr. Talbert also discussed the attached list of airport projects which are a part of the long range plans for the airport.

Mr. Thomas made a motion, seconded by Mrs. Hughes, approved 4 - 0 that the name of the airport be changed from Clemson-Oconee County Airport to Oconee County Regional Airport.

Upon recommendation of Mr. Joe Newton, SC Appalachian Council of Governments, Mr. Timms made a motion, seconded by Mrs. Hughes, approved 3 - 1 (Mr. Thomas voting against) that the classification/compensation study for county employees be conducted every three years.

Upon recommendation of Mr. Hugh Foster, Chairman, Housing & Revitalization Committee, Mr. Timms made a motion, seconded by Mr. Hamilton, approved 4 - 0 that the program be administered as a grant program, not a loan program and the revitalization of housing be for owner-occupied homes only.

Consideration of a request by Pioneer Rural Water District for a resolution in support of upgrade/expansion project relating to water distribution system serving rural areas of Oconee County was withdrawn from the agenda at the request of Pioneer Rural Water District.

Mr. Thomas made a motion, seconded by Mr. Timms, approved 3 - 1 (Mr. Hamilton voting against) that Ordinance 98-6, "1998-99 OCONEE COUNTY BUDGET ORDINANCE" be adopted on second reading.

Upon recommendation of Captain Terry Wilson & Ms. Marianne Dillard, Purchasing Agent, Mr. Timms made a motion, seconded by Mr. Thomas, approved 4 - 0 that the bid for surveillance equipment for the Law Enforcement Center be awarded to Carolina Burglar & Fire Alarm Company who was low bid at \$9,285. (See attached bid sheet)

Upon recommendation of Mr. Dewitt Mize, Rural Fire Marshal & Ms. Dillard, Mr. Hamilton made a motion, seconded by Mrs. Hughes, approved 4 - 0 that the bid for clean up absorbents for Rural Fire be awarded to Safeco, Inc. who was low bid at \$5,379.15. (See attached bid sheet)

Upon recommendation of Mr. Lee Davis, Motor Pool Foreman, & Ms. Dillard, Mr. Hamilton made a motion, seconded by Mrs. Hughes, approved 4 - 0 that the bid for the fuel management system be awarded to Acme Petroleum & Fuel Company (Fuelman of the Carolinas) at \$.10 per gallon. Acme was the only responsive bidder.

Mr. Timms made a motion, seconded by Mr. Hamilton, approved 4 - 0 that the wording for Resolution 98-10, "A RESOLUTION CONCERNING LAKE TUGALO" be adopted.

There was general discussion among the Council Members regarding the ordinance regarding adult entertainment in Oconee County, the coroner using hospital facilities, the transportation committee report of roadways to be upgraded and solid waste needs of the municipalities when the landfill closes.

Old Business

Mr. Thomas, Chairman, Roads & Transportation Committee, informed Council the committee was continuing its work on updating the roadway ordinances.

Ms. Hughes, Chairperson, Purchasing, Contracting, Real Estate, Building & Grounds Committee, scheduled a meeting, Thursday, May 21, 1998 at 6:00 pm for the purpose of discussing workmen's compensation.

There was general discussion regarding the Corinth-Shiloh Fire Department be disciplined for altering county equipment and fire hydrants in the Newry area not working properly.

Mr. Hamilton stated he would contact Mayor Alexander regarding this concern.

Upon request of Mrs. Phyllis Lombard, Finance Director, Mr. Thomas made a motion, seconded by Mr. Hamilton, approved 4 - 0 that \$7,575 be taken from contingency and placed in line item 10 007 00150 00025 for DHEC violation fines to be returned to the Sewer Commission.

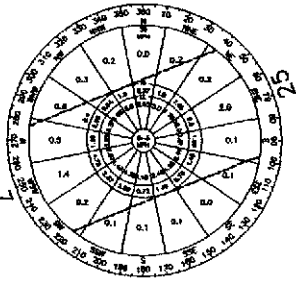

Subscriber will pay a price based on per gallon service fee above Fuelman's laid-in cost as represented by the branded refiner price to resellers in the area; brand specific for each location at the related refiners price to resellers. The service fees per gallon for each fuel product will be as follows:

\$ <u>0.100</u> Unleaded Gasoline	\$ <u>0.100</u> Mid-Grade Gasoline
\$ <u>0.100</u> Premium Gasoline	\$ <u>0.100</u> Diesel Fuel

If locations are unbranded, then the laid-in cost will be represented by the average refiners prices to resellers in the area. Prices will be as shown by the Oil Price Information Service (OPIS) plus freight and applicable taxes. The prices are adjusted on a weekly basis to the OPIS Posting on Thursdays. Included in this price are all of Fuelman's computer reporting and credit costs, profit and overhead. Subscriber has access to OPIS prices from OPIS weekly publications or Fuelman will provide the prices so that Subscriber is assured of fair pricing.

21 Term of Agreement

The Initial Term of this agreement is 12 months from the date of signing of this agreement by the Subscriber. After the Initial Term, renewal can be done for additional periods in 12 month increments.

2.2 In the unlikely event Subscriber should wish to terminate the proposed services provided by Fuelman prior to the end of the initial term of this Agreement, Subscriber will give Fuelman 30 days notice and Fuelman will terminate all cards after such 30 days have elapsed.

3.1 Control Access Cards

All vehicles and drivers will be supplied with control access cards which provide:

- a. Vehicle identification on cards customized by Subscriber.
- b. Security code identification (PIN #'s) to further secure the cards.
- c. Fuel type limitation as desired by vehicle.
- d. Tank capacity limitation.
- e. Instant card loss control (upon reasonable notice to Fuelman of Loss).

3.2 Replacement of Cards, Additional Cards and Spare Cards

Replacement of the access cards will be provided by Fuelman at Fuelman's expense. Card replacements will be timely and are usually mailed on the same day of ordering the cards. New or additional cards for vehicles will be provided at no charge to subscriber.

Spare cards will be provided at initial start-up of service. Spare cards will allow subscriber to begin fueling new equipment immediately. Subscriber shall notify Fuelman of new vehicles that need cards made.

3.3 Consultation Services

Consulting and advisory services related to Fuelman's services to Subscriber are to be provided by Fuelman's customer service personnel on a continual basis.

5. Reporting Techniques, Invoicing, and Payment Terms

Fuel consumption reports are to be transmitted to Subscriber electronically, if desired (IBM compatible diskette or electronic bulletin board), or via printed program reporting (by mail or fax). Weekly Motor Fuel Management Reports are made available on a weekly basis as part of the Fuelman basic package. Other reports which include a weekly usage by employee report, monthly motor fuel summary reports, weekly or monthly fuel exception reports, preventative maintenance reports, month to date/year to date fleet maintenance analysis reports, and other custom reports are available on an optional basis.

5.1 Weekly Motor Fuel Management Report

Complete weekly fuel usage statements for each account number established for Subscriber will include the following information:

- a. Vehicle description (customized to Subscriber's needs)
- b. Driver name
- c. Date and time of fueling
- d. Location of fueling
- e. Odometer reading
- f. Miles per gallon per vehicle, with total miles driven
- g. Gallons and extended price by transaction
- h. Total consumption (dollars & gallons) for the week by vehicle.
- i. Weekly Motor Fuel Management Report is departmentalized to Subscriber's needs.
- j. A summary page for each account number showing by product type: gallons used, # of transactions, extended base price, taxes broken down by federal and state level, and total price including tax. All fuels are subtotaled on the summary page so you can see fuel only totals. Other non-fuel purchases are subtotaled separately including number of transactions, base price, taxes and total. Of course a grand total including Other products is shown. Total miles driven for the account number are shown on the summary page.

5.2 Invoicing For Fuel, Products and Services and Terms of Payment.

Attached to each Weekly Motor Fuel Management Report will be an invoice for the fuel, products and maintenance services consumed by Subscribers fleet for the week. Separate account numbers for various branches of subscriber can be consolidated to one invoice, or separate invoices for each account number and weekly report can be arranged.

- a. All Fuelman invoices are due net amount 7 days from invoice date. A 7 day grace period beyond the due date applies.



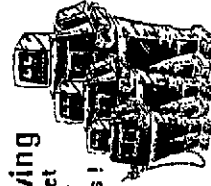
