The meeting was called to order by Supervisor-Chairman Orr who welcomed those present.



WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of the Bond Resolution, Carolina First Bank, Greenville, SC was designated as Registrar and Paying Agent;

NOW THEREFORE, be it contracted and agreed by and between the Board of Trustees of Oconee County GO 2000 and Carolina First Bank as follows:

ARTICLE I

Certain terms written in this agreement with initial capitals have been defined in the Bond Resolution. When used herein, such terms have the meanings given to them in the Bond Resolution.

ARTICLE II

Carolina First Bank accepts its appointment as Registrar and Paying Agent and in connection with such appointment agrees to serve as the Registrar and Paying Agent of the \$4,115,000 Oconee County GO 2000, to be issued pursuant to the Bond Resolution (the "Bonds"), and agrees to be bound by and abide with the terms and conditions of the Bond Resolution defining the functions, duties and powers of the office of the Registrar and Paying Agent. Carolina First Bank hereby certifies that it is lawfully empowered to execute and perform the duties of the Registrar and Paying Agent contemplated and as provided under the Bond Resolution.

ARTICLE III

Carolina First Bank acknowledges that it has received a certified copy of the Bond Resolution.

ARTICLE IV

The Board of Trustees of Oconee County GO 2000 agrees to pay to Carolina First Bank reasonable compensation for its services according to its standard fee schedule (see attachment) in effect at the time those services are rendered and to pay all of its expenses, including counsel fees, which it may incur while acting hereunder. To the extent that any portion of the compensation has been agreed to by any separate agreement, such separate agreement shall control, to the extent so intended.

ARTICLE V

This Agreement will be executed in several counterparts, all or any one of which shall be regarded for all purposes as duplicate originals and shall constitute and be one and the same instrument.

ARTICLE VI
