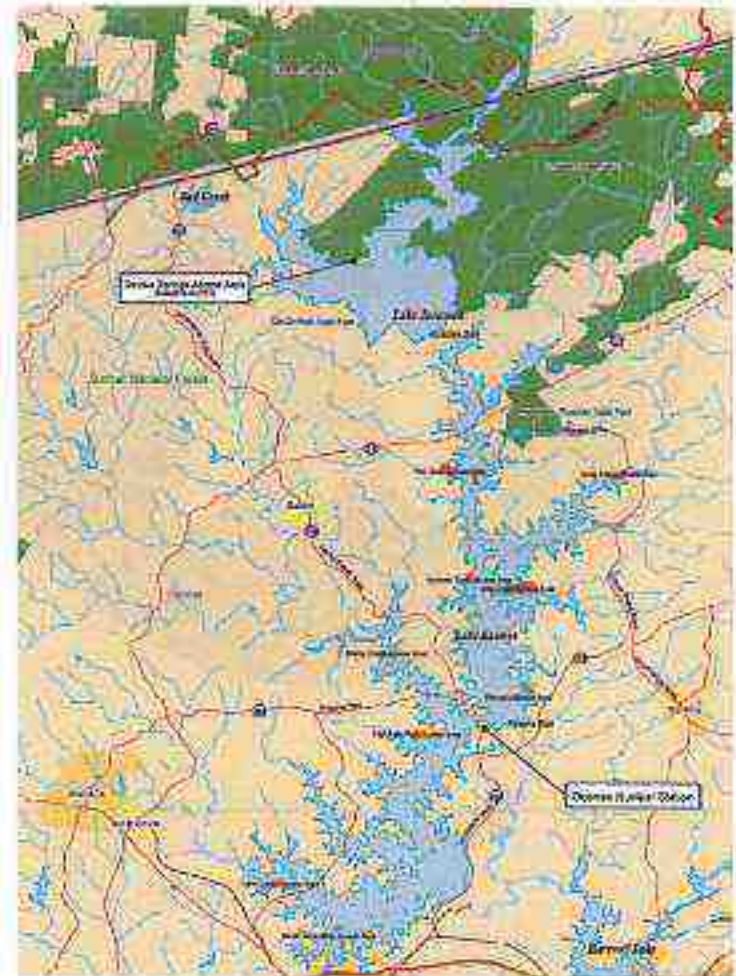

Keowee-Toxaway (KT) Hydro Project Overview



- 2 Developments (Keowee, Jocassee)
- 2 States, 3 Counties
 - Oconee County, SC
 - Pickens County, SC
 - Transylvania, NC
- KT Project Uses – Electric power generation (primary), public water supply, recreation
- 867.60 MW
- Original License Issued 1966, expires 8/31/2016
- License Application Due August 2014



FERC Relicensing

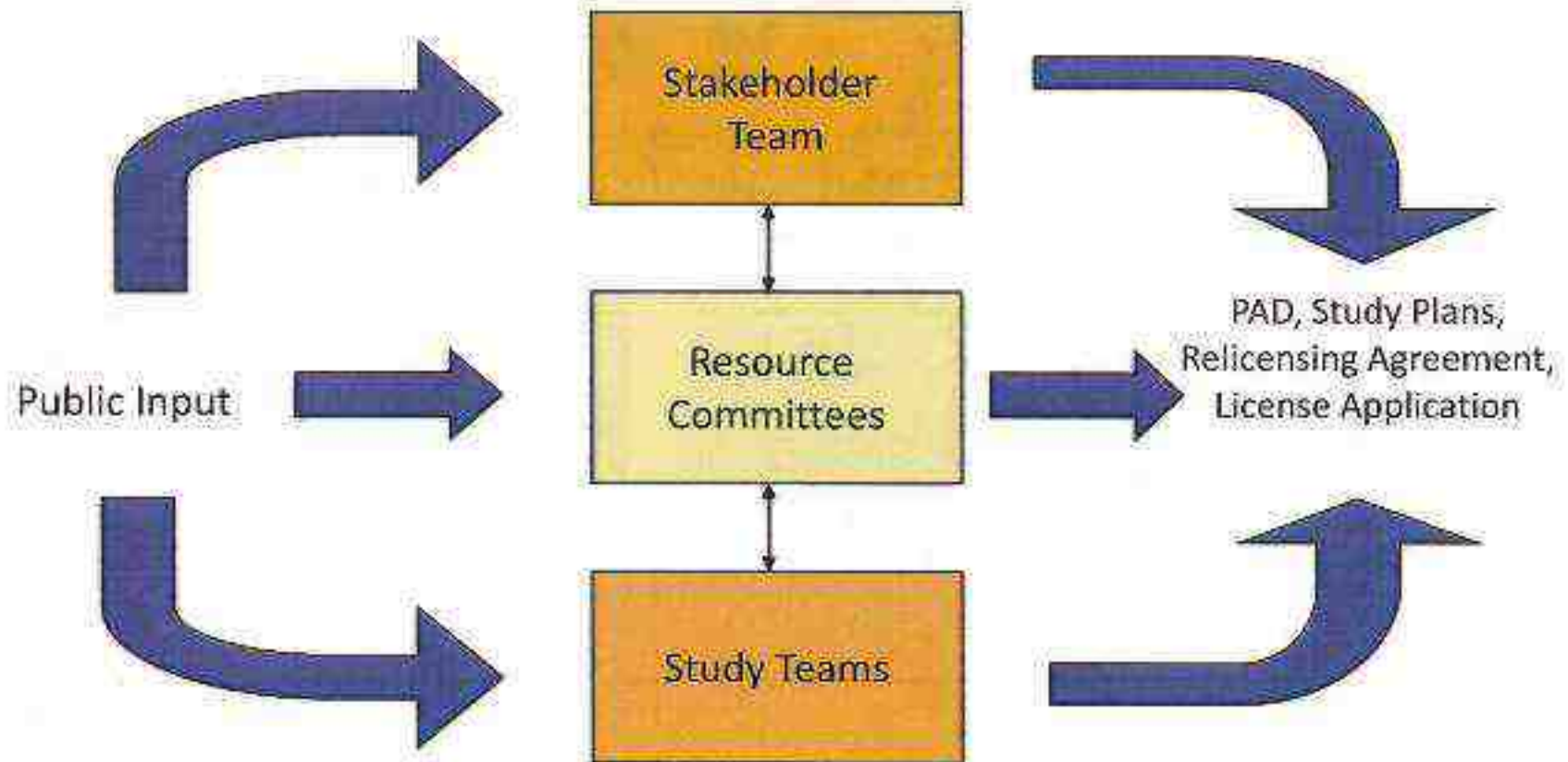
- New License Term: 30 – 50 years
- Typical Relicensing Issues
 - Recreational access
 - Lake use permitting
 - Lake levels
 - Water use
 - Water quality
 - Species protection
- Relicensing process: 5 ½ years

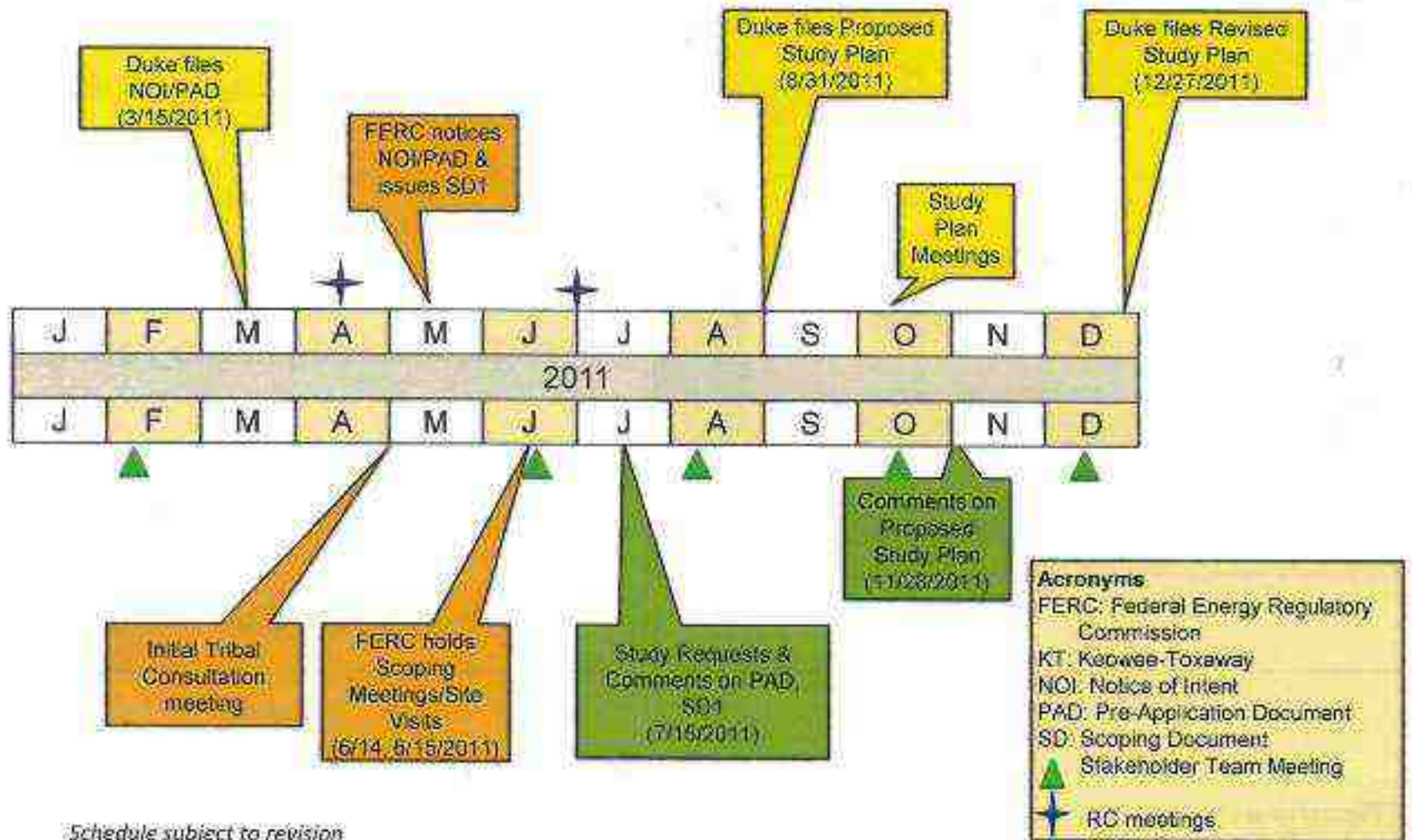
