Oconee County Council met at 9:30 A.M. in Council Chambers, 415 South Pine Street, Walhalla, SC with all Council Members [except Mr. McCall], County Attorney David Root, and Katie. D. Smith, Clerk to Council, present.

Call to Order:

Ms. Cammick called the meeting to order at 9:31 a.m.

Mr. Davis made a motion, seconded by Mr. Cain, to continue to include Mr. Bill Bruehl and Mr. John Elliott in the interview process.

Discussion continued to include:

- Hold off until January
- Qualified candidates
- Intend to include employees and residents in this process

Regarding the previous motion made by Mr. Davis, seconded by Mr. Cain, the motion **failed** 2 – 2 [Mr. Cammick & Mr. Hart opposed] to include Mr. Bill Bruehl and Mr. John Elliott in the interview process.

Executive Session:

Mr. Hart made a motion, seconded by Ms. Cammick, to enter into Executive Session for the following purposes, as allowed for in § 30-4-70(a) of the South Carolina Code of Laws:

[1] To discuss employment matter, and receive legal advice as necessary, related to hiring of County Administrator, including candidate interviews.

Council's meetings shall be conducted pursuant to the South Carolina Freedom of Information Act, Council's Rules and the Model Rules of Parliamentary Procedure for South Carolina Counties, latest edition. This agenda may not be inclusive of all issues which Council may bring up for discussion at this meeting. Items are listed on Council's agenda to give public notice of the subjects and issues to be discussed, acted upon, received as information and/or disposed of during the meeting. Items listed on Council's agenda may be taken up, tabled, postponed, reconsidered, removed or otherwise disposed of as provided for under Council's Rules, and Model Rules of Parliamentary Procedure for South Carolina Counties, latest edition, if not specified under Council's rules.

Council entered Executive Session at 9:35 a.m.

Council returned from Executive Session at 11:45 a.m. on a motion made by Mr. Davis, seconded by Mr. Hart, approved 4 – 0.

Ms. Cammick stated that no action was taken in Executive Session.
